OUR MISSION

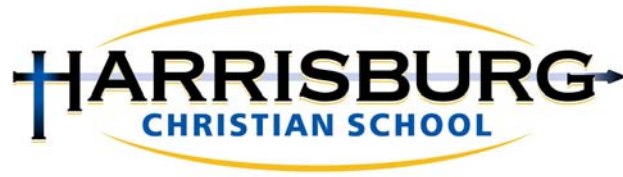

Admission Application Check List

Upon receipt of all completed application materials, an admissions testing date is assigned for the student(s). After testing is completed, family interviews are set up for each family.

Admissions Testing:

The school administers the Otis Lennon School Ability Test for entrance into grades 1-12. Students applying for admission into first grade are also given comprehensive pre-reading and pre-math tests from the Stanford Early School Achievement Test. The Reading Comprehension and Math Problem Solving sections from the Stanford Achievement Test are also given to students entering grades 1-12. Students entering into kindergarten are given a developmental screening test. The principal reviews all data collected and makes a recommendation whether or not to continue the enrollment process. If there is cause to not admit a student, written notification will be sent.

Family Interviews:

A private family interview will be scheduled between the family and the Admissions Committee.

Notification of Decisions:

The Admissions Committee members, after interviewing the family, make a recommendation of acceptance or denial to the Board of Education. The Board approves the recommendation by the Admissions Committee. Acceptance or denial of student(s) will be made by written notification.

Acceptance of Enrollment:

With the completion of all steps for admission, families will be notified of acceptance for enrollment. A registration fee per child (*non-refundable*) will be due upon notification of acceptance.

PARENT INFORMATION

- ◆ Prospective Kindergarten students must be five years old by September 1st of the school year; prospective first grade students must be six years old by September 1st of the school year.
- ◆ A transfer student will not be admitted after the school year begins unless extenuating circumstances exist or the family has just moved into the area.
- ◆ For students first entering school and those entering grades 6 and 11, a physical examination by a physician is required. For students first entering school and those entering grades 3 and 7, a dental examination is required.
- ◆ All students are accepted on a probationary status. At the end of the first marking period, each student's academic progress, attendance record and behavioral pattern will be reviewed to determine if the child should continue at the school. This process will be repeated at the end of the second marking period if the situation warrants.
- ◆ The school has the discretion of not admitting students who have been expelled from another school, have repeated more than one grade, who require significant special education needs, have been asked to leave their school program due to poor behavior, have used illegal substances, have been in trouble with police or have a court record.
- ◆ The school reserves the right to dismiss any family which does not fulfill its obligations or does not pay tuition regularly as set forth in school policy.
- ◆ The main objectives of Harrisburg Christian School's uniform dress code are:
 - a. School dress will be God honoring, positively reflecting (pleasing to) the character of our Heavenly Father and consistent with the quality of education offered at HCS.
 - b. School dress will be modest, not calling attention to one's self, but esteeming others better than us.
 - c. School dress will reflect an attitude of humility, not causing another to stumble.
 - d. School attire must be properly sized—not form fitting or too large or calling attention to the physical body.
 - e. School dress will be neat and in good repair.
 - f. Uniforms are to be solely purchased from *Flynn & O'Hara Uniforms, Inc.* The administration makes the final judgment concerning all uniform clothing and grooming regarding whether it meets the criteria and intent of the dress code.
 - g. It is understood that the student's attire is primarily a parental responsibility. Therefore, parents must become *very familiar* with the uniform dress code.

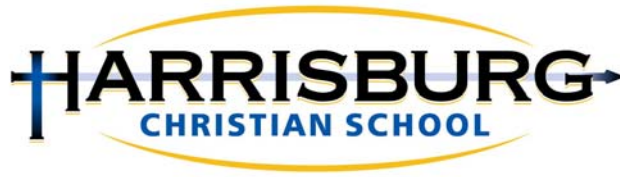

Harrisburg Christian School TUITION, FEES, AND TUITION ASSISTANCE

Tuition:

- ◆ Tuition is paid monthly with the first payment due on July 1st prior to the beginning of the school year, with the last payment due on June 1st just before the close of the year.
- ◆ All new families must pay their tuition via electronic funds transfer (EFT).
- ◆ Please note that tuition may be paid in full via check and receive a 2% discount. Tuition may also be paid in full via credit card with no 2% discount.
- ◆ Tuition payments are due on the first of the month. All late payments are assessed a 5% late fee. If tuition is 30 days past due, a letter will be sent to the parent(s)/guardian(s) requesting payment of the late tuition. If tuition is 60 days past due then a letter is sent to the parent(s)/guardian(s) stating that their child(ren) will not be permitted to attend school until the situation is remedied. Parents and guardians are reminded that their children are subject to state compulsory attendance laws despite their exclusion from school due to nonpayment of tuition. If Harrisburg Christian School is required to file judgment to receive payment of past due tuition, it will be the responsibility of the family in arrears to pay all legal costs.
- ◆ **Please note the “early withdrawal fee” in the fee section of this document.**

Tuition Assistance:

- ◆ Tuition assistance grants are available through HCS as well as outside organizations. These are grants and not loans. HCS tuition assistance is distributed based on need and availability of funds. Need is determined through the confidential *Family Financial Needs Assessment* (FFNA) agency. FFNA applications for tuition assistance from HCS must be applied for during the application process via the FFNA website: www.ffna1.com (HCS School I.D.—2733). Tuition assistance grants must be applied for each year. Applications for tuition assistance grants from outside organizations may be obtained from the Business Office.
- ◆ Since HCS tuition assistance is provided through budgeted, fundraised, and donated monies, it is the policy of HCS only to consider an application for HCS tuition assistance after the family has applied to all outside tuition assistance organizations specified by the school for which they qualify. Tuition assistance funds are provided on a first come-first served basis and are awarded on the basis of family need and availability of funds.
- ◆ Parents may be asked to apply for scholarships through organizations funded by eligible corporations. Any grants will help pay for tuition assistance grants given by HCS.

Harrisburg Christian School TUITION, FEES, AND TUITION ASSISTANCE

Fees:

- ◆ **Application Fee:** This application processing fee is charged for each new student that seeks enrollment at HCS.

- ◆ **Registration Fee:** This fee is a non-refundable fee payable upon the registration of each and every student.

- ◆ **Late Pickup Fee:** After school child care is not provided by the school. It is very important that parent(s)/guardian(s) make arrangements for their non-bussed children to be picked up promptly after school.

- ◆ **Discovery Learning Support Center Testing Fee:** These fees are charged to a family of a student being considered for participation in this remedial learning program.

- ◆ **Challenge Program Fee:** This fee is charged to a family of a student that is accepted into this enrichment program.

- ◆ **Early Withdrawal Fee:** When a student withdraws after registering for the school year an early withdrawal fee is assessed. While a student might leave the school for unavoidable reasons (illness, job transfer, etc.) the school continues to bear the costs of the student with no tuition income. Families must pay one month's tuition, in addition to all tuition expenses.

Withdrawal prior to July 1st - Withdrawal fee is one month's tuition (registration fee is not refundable).

Withdrawal prior to August 1st - Withdrawal fee is one month's tuition plus the tuition payment for the month of July (registration fee is not refundable).

Withdrawal prior to September 1st - Withdrawal fee is one month's tuition plus the tuition payments for the months of July and August (registration fee is not refundable).

Withdrawal during the school year - Withdrawal fee is one month's tuition plus the tuition up to and including the month in which the student leaves (registration fee is not refundable).

- ◆ To seek unity of the believers, especially when offense is taken by following the guidelines found in Matthew 18:15-20.
- ◆ To attend all regular Association meetings (three per year) in order to stay informed of the school activities and procedures, and to be actively functioning in the school.
- ◆ To understand and follow the financial policies of the Association, including the responsibility of promptly paying tuition for your children.
- ◆ To support and work in the school's fundraising programs to help offset the gap between tuition and the total cost of operating the school. Parents electing not to fundraise will pay a higher tuition for their child(ren).
- ◆ To support the school financially through tax deductible gifts when possible.
- ◆ To adhere to and follow the regulations that are found in the Parent/Student Handbook.
- ◆ To understand that parents are responsible for any visual, dental, or medical attention and/or insurance needed by their children while they are in attendance at Harrisburg Christian School.
- ◆ To supply written proof of necessary immunizations and proof of age at registration.
- ◆ To give the school administration and teachers full discretion in regard to student discipline while your children are under their authority within the stated policies of the school.
- ◆ To understand that families involved at HCS on any level are expected to maintain a pure testimony in all that they do, including attitudes and behavior at school and elsewhere.
- ◆ To refrain from bringing HCS to court to resolve disputes. Families will pursue Christian mediation or arbitration to resolve disputes when needed.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

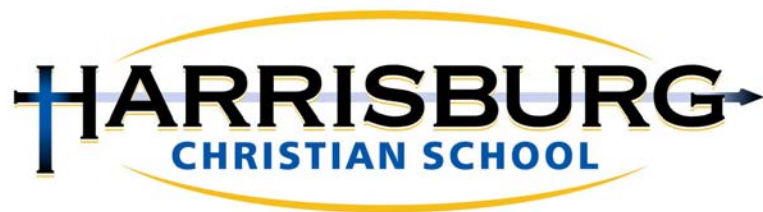
- ◆ We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
