

## Plans (Both Before & After School)

The HCS Extended Care Program is a flexible program designed to meet your various care and payment needs.

### After-School Yearly Care **\$1,500**

*\$576 savings over the daily rate*

- Payable on September 1<sup>st</sup>
- Multi-child discount available

### After-School Monthly Care **\$190/Month**

**\$1,710/Year**

*\$366 savings over the daily rate*

- Payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month (9/1-5/1)
- Multi-child discount available

### After-School Daily Care **\$12/Day**

**\$228/Month**

**\$2,076/Year**

- Payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> of each mo. (9/1-5/1)
- Multi-child discount available

### Before-School Daily Care **\$3/Hour\***

**\$57/Month**

- Price based on registration in After-School Yearly or Monthly Payment Plans
- Payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month (9/1-5/1)

\* Discount rate (\$3/Hour) apply to those registered in both HCS After-School Yearly/Monthly Care and Before-School Care. A rate of \$5 is charged for those registered in Before-School Care only.

**Financial Procedures:** All payments will be made via EFT through the HCS Business Office. An hourly rate of \$6 per hour is available for those who do not need the After-School Care on a regular basis. Hourly rates are rounded to next full hour. A rate of \$1 per minute per child will be charged for all pick-ups after 6 PM. All rates are based upon the following data: 173 School Days / 9 Months (4.3 Weeks or 19 Days per month) / 35 Weeks

## Purpose

## Program

### SNACK TIME (3:15 PM - 3:30 PM)

Snack time is first thing on the schedule for extended care. Your child should bring a snack (drink and treat) to extended care on a daily basis.



### RECREATION TIME (3:30 PM - 4:15 PM)

Children in the after school care program will have time to participate in developmentally appropriate interactive activities and meaningful play experiences. Weather permitting students will have access to supervised play on the playground and an assortment of interactive play centers.

### ACADEMIC TIME (4:20 PM - 5:00 PM)

Students will have the opportunity to complete homework, study, read on their own or in groups, and receive extra academic support. Students should come each day with a book to read and an activity book. This valuable time today will help students prepare for academic success tomorrow.



### ENRICHMENT TIME (5:00 PM - 5:30 PM)

Children will have opportunity to participate in several enrichment activities including:

- Spanish Education (M & TH)
- Arts & Crafts (W)
- Technology Enrichment (T & F)



## Procedures

**Eligibility:** The HCS Extended Care Program (ECP) is open to HCS students in Grades K-8 only.

**Behavior:** Children are expected to be *polite, respectful* of others and the property of others, and *helpful* in creating a positive, cooperative environment. If praise and encouragement does not assist a child in improving their behavior then a short period of recreational time will be taken away. The next step would be to call for a parent conference. The Director may dismiss a child from the program whose behavior is an ongoing concern and/or a threat to the health and safety of others.

**Health & Safety:** To ensure the care of all children, children with a 100-degree temperature will not be allowed in the ECP for that day. Children should be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to the program.

**Arrival & Pick-Up:** Only pre-authorized persons shall be allowed to pick-up your child from ECP. Due to after school activities and general safety, parents will be asked to park in the parking spaces and come to the main school entrance. Upon ringing the door bell, an Attendant will provide an authorized person access to the building to pick-up their child(ren). Children will not be dismissed to the parking lot without an authorized person. Parents are asked to supervise their children following pick-up. Parents can help end their child's day in a positive way by (1) allowing time for their child to finish an activity they are involved in; (2) encouraging their child to put away equipment, toys, and supplies they were playing with; and (3) making sure their child has all of their personal items before leaving.
